The Museum

DALANE FOLKEMUSEUM is a regional museum for Dalane, the southernmost part of the county Rogaland, encompassing the municipalities Bjerkreim, Lund, Sokndal and Eigersund.

The museum was founded in 1910. Its administration and main exhibitions are located at Slettebø in Egersund. Dalane Folkemuseum has several departments and buildings spread throughout the region.

Dalane Folkemuseum



DALANE FOLKEMUSEUM is located in idyllic surroundings just outside Egersund. Built around 1850, it was originally the location of district judge Christian Feyer's country estate. The area later housed a German military encampment during World War 2.

The beautiful garden, the buildings and the larch forest make out the museum's framework. The exhibitions give an insight into everyday life in Dalane during the 1800s and early 1900s. Thematic exhibitions focus on agriculture, traditional handicrafts and World War 2.

The main building houses various exhibitions. The three main living rooms through furnishing represent different centuries. There are also two reconstructed rural living rooms, examples of church art and a collection of cast iron stove plates.

Egersund Fayancemuseum



EGERSUND FAYANCEMUSEUM tells the story of Egersunds Fayancefabrik, a factory that for 132 years provided pottery for the Norwegian people. Different periods within art and fashion are mirrored in the extensive production.

The museum is housed in one of the old factory buildings, today the location of the Amfi Eikunda shopping mall. This provides an opportunity to relive the rich history that made the

factory the most important workplace in the city.

The museum is universally designed. There is a special touch-gallery designed for the visually impaired. The museum hosts various activities for children, among them *Play with Clay*, where they can make and fire their own ceramic products.

The Bilstad house



THE BILSTAD HOUSE is the name of the property located in Nygaten 14 in Egersund. The property encompasses a complete townhouse complex, with a residential building, a sailmaker's workshop, a barn and a granary, as well as a courtyard and garden.

What is special about the Bilstad house is its original 1900s interior. This includes the original floor plan, wallpaper and colorings, as well as intact furniture and décor from the early 1900s. The house provides a unique historical insight into the life of an Egersund-family through 128 years.

Helleren



HELLEREN IN JØSSINGFJORD creates a natural roof and shelter used by humans for millennia. The two houses stem from the 19th century, but parts of the buildings are likely to be older. People have presumably lived in the area since the 16th century.

In their dramatic modesty, the houses beneath Helleren are among our greatest cultural heritage sites. With their authenticity, they tell us more about ourselves, our history and identity than anything else.

Mysinghåla



MYSINGHÅLÅ functioned to shelter people that were part of the resistance movement during World War 2. The cave was furnished with a stove, sleeping benches, a table and a window.

Acts of espionage and sabotage against the Germans were carried out from Mysinghåla. The Germans never located the hideout.

The hike to Mysinghåla takes about 40 minutes and is suitable for the whole family. Parking facilities by the Mysing farm. Signs along route E39 between Helleland and Ualand mark the exit.

Sogndalstrand Maritime Museum



THE MARITIME MUSEUM

is located in an old boathouse, an attraction in itself, in the idyllic and beautiful Sogndalstrand.

Around 1820, great amounts of herring migrated to the coast outside of Dalane. Herring was a big source of income and provided work for many. Fishing took place from open boats, rowing or sailing, and so the boathouses had to be located near the fishing grounds. The museum building is an original boathouse from this period. The museum acquired the boathouse in the 1950s. It is built with a combination of

stave and log construction, a technique called *reisverk*, and has three stories. It stands on dry-stacked stone pillars and has dry stone main stairs.

This facility is currently closed for maintenance. A visit to lovely Sogndalstrand is still warmly recommended.

Fuglestad Millhouse Complex



THE MILLHOUSE COMPLEX AT FUGLESTAD is the largest among the many belonging to Dalane Folk Museum. Today it consists of three millhouses and a grain dryer. The millhouses were built around 1840, and the grain dryer sometime during the 1870s.

The complex originally belonged to and was run by the tenants at Fuglestad. The buildings were meant to cover the tenants' need for flour, but were for a period rentable, under the name of *Fuglestad Mølle*. The millhouse complex was operational until 1945.

The millhouses are located in idyllic surroundings, ideal for a picnic or for going swimming in the summer. All use of fire is forbidden.

The road to Fuglestad is marked by sign near Brusand, along County Road 44.

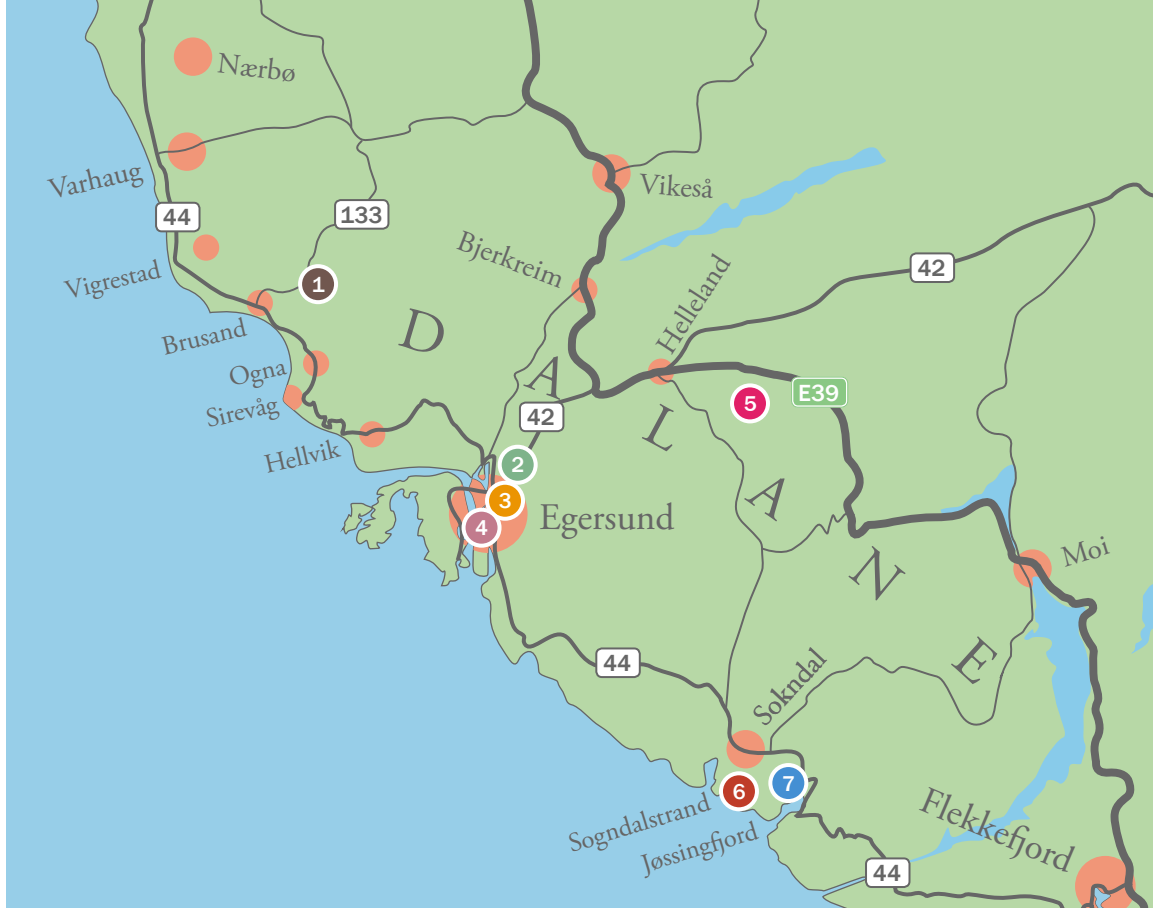
